ment has triggered an increase in the demand for distribution centers offering a wide portfolio of VAL services. In response, Yusen India has opened a number of new warehousing facilities, and has taken its first steps into the Indian logistics market.



The new Bangalore warehouse is located less than one hour from Bangalore International Airport by car, and approximately 30 minutes from the Inland Container Depot. The new warehousing facility will bring just-in-time distribution to the Bangalore area, deploying the company's own trucks. The outskirts of southern Delhi is home to countless factories operated by companies in the automotive, motorcycle, machinery, chemicals, and consumer electronics industries. The start of the construction of a cargo transport road from Delhi to Mumbai has seen the region experience a wave of cargo depot and industrial complex constructions. As a result, the penetration of international businesses into the area is accelerating. ## Activities Warehousing & Distribution

The flow of goods is being managed by an efficient Warehouse Management System. The inventory management is controlled by Weblogi2 – an inventory management system designed to fulfill the specific needs of our client base.

A unique password allows our clients to enter the system and monitor their inventories 24/7.

More than 90% of the goods handled and stored in the above mentioned warehousing facilities are entering the Netherlands by ocean. The remaining 10% are goods flown in by air. Taking into consideration the recent shift of the international flows of goods from air to sea transportation, it should be expected that the share of sea freighted goods handled in our logistics centers will increase in the coming year.

Parallel to the increase of ocean freighted flows, the need for warehousing and distribution services is expected to grow as well. In answer to this development, the warehousing capacity of Yusen Air & Sea will be expanded in the near future.

### NEW REGULATION:

## Ocean freight to USA 10+2 ISF

### (IMPORTER SECURITY FILING)

10+2/ISF has been designed to further secure the supply chain against terrorism and was enacted by U.S. Congress in the SAFE Port Act of 2006. The SAFE Port Act mandated CPB (Custom & Border Protection) to collect additional data elements and require data to be received prior to vessel loading and improve the targeting process (to target potential terrorist acts).

The implementation of the regulation has not been finalized yet, however, it is expected to be in place at the end of 2008.

In addition to the already existing information requirements, 10 additional data elements will have to be transmitted and accepted by the Custom & Border Protection 24 hours before loading the vessel.

The 10 requirements are:

- Manufacturer (or supplier) name and address
- Seller name and address
- Buyer name and address
- "Ship to" name and address
- Container stuffing location
- Consolidator (stuffer) name and address
- Importer of record number
- Consignee IRS number
- Country of origin
- Commodity HTS number (6 digit level)

2 additional elements must be supplied by the actual carrier (shipping line):

- Vessel stow plan (vessel name and operator, voyage number, container operator, equipment number, size and type, stow position, hazmat code, load/discharge ports)
- Container status message (terminal container movements, change in container status, and others).

*In the coming months, Yusen USA will be monitoring the implementation of 10+2 regulation and will provide its customers with an updated status.*
